Day Three

Our Novena Prayer

With childlike wonder and dependence, you saw Jesus as the elevator to lift you up through challenging times. Life presented you many challenges: health; hypersensitivity that made you easily hurt; criticism from others; being misunderstood, unnoticed or underappreciated; deaths; disappointments; and dark nights of senses and spirit. You had to walk many stairways to get the bigger picture of what was really happening. Yes, you wanted to be carried, as we often want God to fix things, but you learned to take each step, knowing that the energy came from God's presence deep within you.

Teach us how to trust the presence of Jesus' Spirit deep within, enabling us to walk through challenging times with humble gratitude that Jesus is carrying and sustaining us. Awaken us to know we are not alone, but unconditionally befriended by Jesus, who never leaves us and walks with and within us. As you teach "everything is grace," help us trust that we are riding a hidden escalator of grace.

Day Seven

Our Novena Prayer
